



BACK TO SCHOOL

Questions Every Parent Should Ask

Sadly, public schools aren't what they once were. While many teachers are doing their best to properly educate our children, radical organizations are working as one to indoctrinate America's children into extreme ideologies. Aside from the direct harm this brings to children, another goal is to undermine parental authority and drive a wedge between parents and their children.

Before sending your child back to school, it is imperative to ask your school these questions:

- 1 Does your child's school teach Sex Ed and/or Gender Theory?
- 2 Does your child's school teach Critical Race Theory (CRT), Diversity, Equity and Inclusion (DEI) or Ethnic Studies?
- 3 Does your child's school use a teaching method called *Social and Emotional Learning (SEL)*?
- 4 As a parent, do you have access to the school library and your child's curriculum?
- 5 Does your child's school conduct personally intrusive student surveys that violate student and family privacy?
- 6 Does your child's school recruit students into extra-curricular clubs that are ideological or political in nature?
- 7 As a parent, do you have the right to "Opt-Out" of any of these activities?

These questions should tell you that something is seriously wrong with America's schools today. Find out if harmful ideologies have infiltrated the schools you fund and entrust to teach your kids.

- 1 Does your child's school teach a form of "Comprehensive Sexuality Education"? Does it teach that gender is fluid, using pictographs like the "Genderbread Person"? Do you have access to review these materials and/or curriculums? Does your school keep secrets about students and hide "gender transitioning" from their parents? What restroom/locker room policies are in place regarding gender identity? Does your school offer confidential medical and mental health services to students? Does your school have relationships with third party providers that offer abortions or "Gender Affirming Care"?
- 2 Does your child's school teach CRT, DEI or Ethnic Studies? Does it teach that America is systemically racist, that its history is rooted in white patriarchy, or that society is separated by oppressed and oppressors according to race? Does it encourage white students to "atone for their privilege"?
- 3 Are your child's teachers trained in *Social and Emotional Learning*? Do school counselors provide mental health therapy without parental knowledge and consent? Do faculty members intrude into students' personal lives and collect private information about students and parents' political and religious values? How is this data used?
- 4 Do you have online access to all library books, curriculums and materials? Can you request a record of books that your child has checked out, or block child access to materials you deem inappropriate or harmful? Can you access content that is furnished to your child, on all technology platforms including tablets, desktops and apps?
- 5 Does your child's school conduct surveys that examine students' sexual behaviors, gender identity, drug use, religion, politics or personal family attitudes? How is the data used? Are there policies in place to notify you about such surveys, provide access to the content and the ability to opt your child out?
- 6 What third party organizations are invited on campus to recruit and interact with your child? Are there political, ideological, or religious student clubs or activist training sessions that are made available to your child?
- 7 What are the school's policies with regard to opting your child out of certain subjects and/or exposure to certain materials you may find objectionable? Will the school notify you before such materials are offered? Can you opt your child out of what you consider objectionable material? How is this accomplished?
